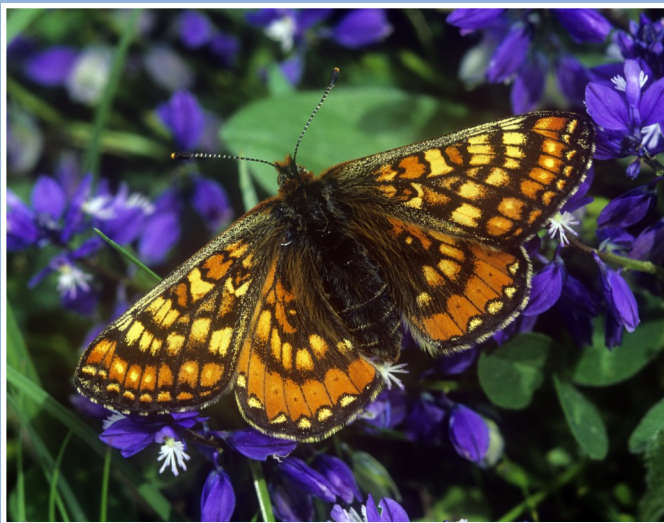

How many different kinds of flowers can you find?

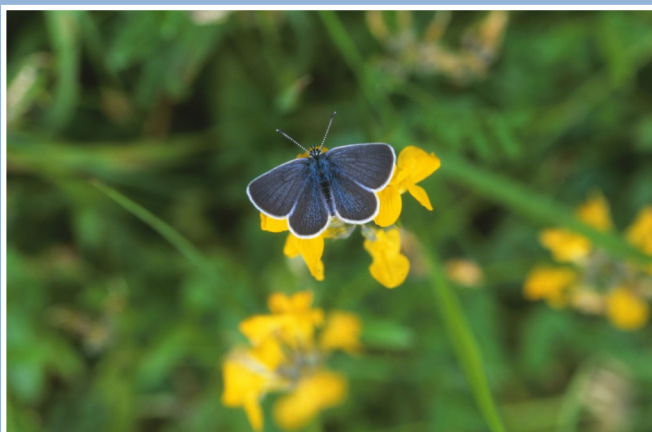
