Glossary of Sheep Terms

Ewe	a female sheep
Ram	a male sheep
Lamb	a young sheep
Sheep	a mammal with a thick woolly coat that eats grass and is usually kept on farms for its meat or wool
Flock	a group of sheep
Herdwick	a hardy breed of sheep native to the Lake District
Farm	an area of land, usually with buildings, used for growing crops and raising animals
Fleece	the thick covering of wool on a sheep
Shearing	cutting the wool off a sheep
Carding	the process of using wire brushes to separate the fibres of wool to prepare it for spinning
Spinning	a method of producing wool from fibres by twisting them together
Wool	the coat of a sheep or the yarn or fibres made from this
