Jones' Mill is home to wildlife that thrives in wet conditions.

Can you spot the great horsetail plant?



Or a water vole?



In summer there are many different kinds of plants, such as the yellow flag iris.

How many different kinds of plants can you find?



At Jones' Mill you might also see cows.

They eat the grass. If this didn't happen, the reserve would turn into a woodland.



The cows help to maintain a rich diversity of plants.



The landscape at Jones' Mill has lots of ditches and ridges. It was previously a water meadow.

Watercress was grown here for markets in London.
